

Randy Jedele is a member of the writing faculty and the Chair of Humanities at Des Moines Area Community College (DMACC). In addition to his teaching and chair responsibilities, Jedele also serves the college in numerous capacities; he is the Coordinator of Learning Communities, a community college representative for a National Science Foundation grant shared with DMACC and Iowa State, a member of the Online Oversight Committee, a participant on the English Department's assessment team, and on the Executive Board of the college's Higher Education Association.

Jedele earned his doctorate Educational Leadership and Policy Studies from Iowa State University in 2007. The majority of his doctoral research, as well as the topic for his dissertation, was focused on learning communities, their benefits for students, especially community college students; their advantages for persistence to complete a semester and their retention to the next semester; and their impact on faculty growth and development.

Most recently, Jedele completed his second semester as DMACC's London Study Abroad coordinator and professor. During the 2005 and 2009 spring semester, Jedele taught DMACC students at the University of London. Besides classroom responsibilities, he coordinated fieldtrips in and around London, as well as a four-day trip to Paris to study architecture and art.

Jedele has been a member of NACADA since 1997, when he attended his first Summer Institute at Madison, Wisconsin. Since that first Summer Institute, Jedele has participated in six additional institutes, one as a participant and five as a faculty member. In addition, he was integral in assisting the Gay and Lesbian Interest Group to become the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgendered, and Allies Concerns Commission. He served as the first chair of that commission. He has also chaired the Faculty Advising Commission and served on various NACADA committees. Jedele has also written an award-winning faculty advising handbook and presented at numerous regional and national NACADA conferences.
