

2009 NACADA Region V Advisor Training and Professional Development Grants

To support advisor training and professional development efforts (professional, faculty, or peer), the NACADA Great Lakes Region V steering committee will grant up to \$500.00 to any allied or non-allied advising organizations for this designated purpose. Proposals must include plans for promoting National Academic Advising Association resources, membership, and NACADA related events. In order to apply for this award the advising organization and/or individual must:

- Provide a list of NACADA related resources that will be used.
- Provide a list of the professionals (with at least one person being a NACADA member) taking responsibility for planning, conducting, evaluating, and providing a report back to the Region V steering committee after one year of the intended project.
- If training, provide a description of the type and number of invited advisors (i.e. fulltime, faculty etc.) for this event.
- If training, submit an agenda of the training or professional development activities for which the funds are being requested.
- If on-line materials/activities/training are being developed, provide a list of these and the conceptual model being used.
- Provide a timeline for the project.
- List other sources of financial support.
- Permit other institutions to use the proposed training or professional development activity as a model to develop their own with the understanding that such assistance must be noted.

All applications must be submitted to Nancy Roadruck, nancy5@uakron.edu no later than July 1, 2009. Applications must be submitted electronically using Microsoft Word, 12 pt. type, Times New Roman font, and with a title page that includes the name, business, address, phone and fax number, and e-mail address of the individual presenting the application.

Applicants will be notified prior to the national conference of any awards, and recipients of awards will be recognized at the national conference. Applications will be considered confidential information. Grants will be awarded on a selective basis. Region 5 reserves the right not to select a recipient should the above criteria not be adequately addressed.
