

2009 NACADA Region V Scholarship To Support Individual Professional Development or Academic Coursework

This scholarship is intended to support an individual (professional, faculty, or peer) who is engaging, or seeking to engage, in activities intended to further one's role, function or responsibility within the field of Academic Advising. Examples include costs related to graduate coursework, attendance at training institutes or leadership seminars. It is **NOT** recommended that proposals be submitted for professional development in the form of regional or national conference attendance. The NACADA Great Lakes Region V steering committee may grant up to \$500.00 for this designated purpose. In order to apply for this award the individual must:

- Provide a description of the academic training/course/program for which this scholarship will be used.
- Provide a timeline for the above.
- Provide a description of their personal academic plan or intent.
- List your budget/costs as well as other sources of financial support for this endeavor.
- Describe how this activity (academic training/course/program) relates to academic advising and how this will benefit you (the individual), your department, and the students with whom you work.
- List other professional activities you have completed in the last two years.

All applications must be submitted to Nancy Roadruck, nancy5@uakron.edu no later than July 1, 2009 . Applications must be submitted electronically using Microsoft Word, 12 pt. type, Times New Roman font, and with a title page that includes the name, business, address, phone and fax number, and e-mail address of the individual presenting the application.

Applicants will be notified prior to the national conference of any awards, and recipients of awards will be recognized at the national conference. Applications will be considered confidential information. Grants will be awarded on a selective basis. Region 5 reserves the right not to select a recipient should the above criteria not be adequately addressed.
