

**2009 NACADA Region V Development Grants
To develop Allied Organizations at the State/Province level**

In order to promote the development of allied state and provincial advising organizations in NACADA Great Lakes Region, Region V Steering Committee may grant up to \$500.00 to a group of 35 or more advisors, from at least 4 institutions, within a particular state or province towards the creation of such an organization. Advisors residing in states and provinces with existing allied organizations working with NACADA may not apply for this grant. In order to apply for this award the groups must:

- Have an official name
- Provide a list of the advisors and their e-mail addresses and identify those that are NACADA members
- Provide a list of the institutions to which the advisors belong
- Provide a draft copy of their organization's governance structure or bylaws (or proposed structure/bylaws)
- Provide a draft copy of their organizational plan to hold a one-day state or province advising conference within the next two years
- Provide a copy of the organization's request to become an allied NACADA member <http://www.nacada.ksu.edu/Membership/allied.htm> Please send the original to NACADA

All applications must be submitted to Nancy Roadruck, nancy5@uakron.edu no later than July 1, 2009 . Applications must be submitted electronically using Microsoft Word, 12 pt. type, Times New Roman font, and with a title page that includes the name, business, address, phone and fax number, and e-mail address of the individual presenting the application.

Applicants will be notified prior to the national conference of any awards, and recipients of awards will be recognized at the national conference. Applications will be considered confidential information. Grants will be awarded on a selective basis. Region 5 reserves the right not to select a recipient should the above criteria not be adequately addressed.
