

2008 NACADA Region VII Graduate Student Scholarship Application Procedures

NACADA Region VII Scholarships are presented to a selected NACADA member who is pursuing graduate education at either the Masters or Ph.D. level. The program supports a primary goal of the organization, which is to promote professional training of advisors.

Awards: One scholarship of \$200 for tuition and books, plus scholarship to cover registration fee to the 2008 Region VII conference in Branson, MO.

Eligibility: To be eligible for a scholarship, nominees must be a current member of NACADA, be currently enrolled in either a masters or doctoral program and must have worked as an academic advisor for two years with a minimum of a half-time appointment. Previous Region VII Graduate Scholarship recipients are not eligible.

Following is the application for a NACADA Scholarship. To complete your application, you must submit all of the following documents by **December 3, 2007**:

1. 2008 NACADA Region VII Graduate Student Scholarship Application Form,
2. Career Goals Statement
3. Official transcripts* from all institutions of Higher Education that you have attended
4. Recommendation by Faculty Form (sent directly to Region VII Chair by faculty)
5. Recommendation by Employer Form (sent directly to Region VII Chair by employer)

* Photocopies of an *official* transcript are acceptable.

One copy of all NACADA Region VII Graduate Scholarship application materials must be received by **Friday, December 3, 2007**. NOTE: The employer & faculty recommendation forms will be duplicated upon receipt.

Ask for your recommendation from your faculty member and employer as soon as possible. You may want to give them a pre-addressed envelope for their convenience.
